Our program format is designed to provide a wide range of topics and choices that will be an advantage to students and teachers. For example, country students who study a number of history courses will have a choice of different days to attend.
- ❑ **Remote Subsidy:** As part of our ongoing commitment to supporting remote teachers & students, HTANSW offers the "Remote Subsidy Grant" to facilitate attendance at the HSC History Study Days. Each grant offers up to \$1,000 in transport/accommodation subsidy. This year there will be up to 6* grants available. (*Updated Apr 2019)

- Each student **will pay** the regular admission fee to the Study Days
- Combined applications, with schools sharing transport, are encouraged
- Previous successful applicants may re-apply (but will be given a lower priority)
- See full selection criteria and conditions below

The following conditions will apply:

- **Only applications from schools located more than 300 kilometres from Sydney will be considered**
- **Applying teachers or their school must be CURRENT MEMBERS of HTANSW**
- **Each student will pay admission fee for the Study Days**
- **Students will be expected to attend the lectures with their teacher**

Criteria considered in the selection process include:

- combined applications, with schools sharing transport
- remoteness of school
- maximum of 2 schools from any one area (North Coast, South Coast, North West, South West, West)
- length of membership with the HTA
- Previous support of the HSC Study Days
